Welcome to 7th & 8th grade!

Middle school is time to let your child take the lead in their learning. Let them do it, be patient, give yourself grace, but continue to check in with them daily.

Here are a few things you should know:

First, if you have questions, please <u>ask your child first</u>, they are the one taking the class and should have the answers for you. We want them to be proactive and communicate with their teachers both in person and by email. If you still need answers, then reach out to the teacher. Email is best.

In Language Arts there is a Classical reading requirement – IB students are required to read about 30 pages a week and complete dialectical journals. We will be providing a list of approved novels, but you may see/ask Mrs. Hughes or Mrs. Maiden for books that do not appear on the list. This list is in our google classroom.

Make sure your child is eating and staying hydrated. Middle schoolers are physically growing, they are growth years and sometimes students do not eat or drink water; this can make them cranky or get headaches. Remind them that it is important to eat and drink their water. Water bottles are allowed in classrooms.

Encourage them to "unplug" from all social media an hour before bedtime. Their brains need to calm down for them to sleep. They will tell you they need them as an alarm. Get them a bedside alarm clock. They need the down time.




STUDENT ADVISORY COUNCIL (SAC TEAM)
