Dear Parent or Guardian of Pitman High Incoming 9th grade student:

TUSD provides students with outstanding opportunities in mathematics and English courses to develop students' skills and abilities in those concepts necessary for college and career readiness at the culmination of their high school experience. An important component of success in mathematics and English is appropriate placement. In accordance with California Senate Bill 359, the California Mathematics Placement Act of 2015, the District has developed a procedure to best ensure appropriate courses for students as they enter ninth grade. All incoming 9<sup>th</sup> grade students will be placed into either Integrated Math I or Honors Integrated Math I. Pitman High School offers various opportunities for intervention embedded within the school day. Additionally, all 9<sup>th</sup> grade math courses will have at least one placement checkpoint within the first 30 days of school and verify appropriate placement of student. Contact home will be used to determine math placement for the 2020-2021 school year:

#### <u>Honors Criteria</u>

Students may become qualified for the Honors course by meeting all of the following criteria:

- 1. Minimum score of 2586 on the Smarter Balanced math summative assessment (met or exceeded standards)
- Grade of B or better in Math 8, or C or better in Math 8E/STEM in the third quarter of 8th grade

### Intervention Criteria:

In addition to being enrolled in Integrated Math I, students meeting the following criteria may be considered for supplemental interventions:

- Score of 2503 or lower on the Smarter Balanced math summative assessment (standards not met)
- 2. Teacher recommendation

### English 9 Placement

In addition, your child's English 9 placement is also listed. Placement criteria for your incoming 9<sup>th</sup> grade student was based on their 8<sup>th</sup> grade English teacher's recommendation and 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter grade. Scores from both 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade SBAC/CAASPP assessments will also be taken into account for placement in English 9 as well.
