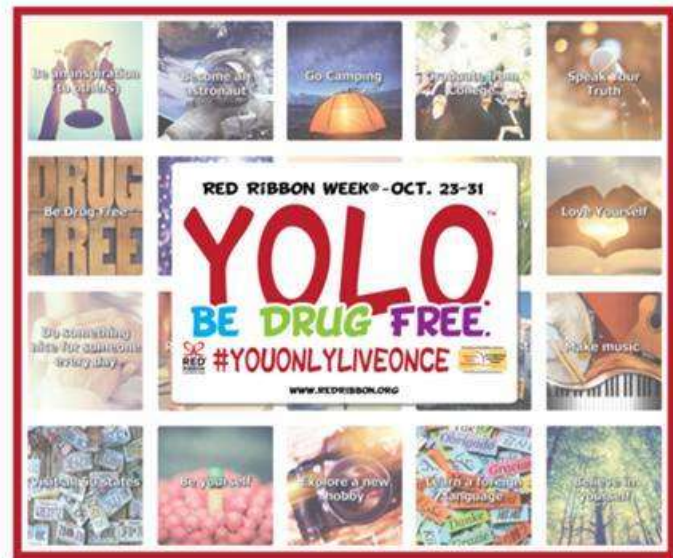

Your design may not exceed 11" (inches) wide and 12" (inches) high and can include up to 4 colors.

One design per entry. However, participants may enter as many entries as they want.

Your design must be wholly original and promote a drug free message.

Entries must be submitted to Mr. Raya by 3:30 P.M. Thursday, November 10. Entries may be submitted on hard copy (paper) or by e-mail to paul.raya@sausd.us. Submissions can also be hand drawn or designed using a design program such as Photoshop or Illustrator.

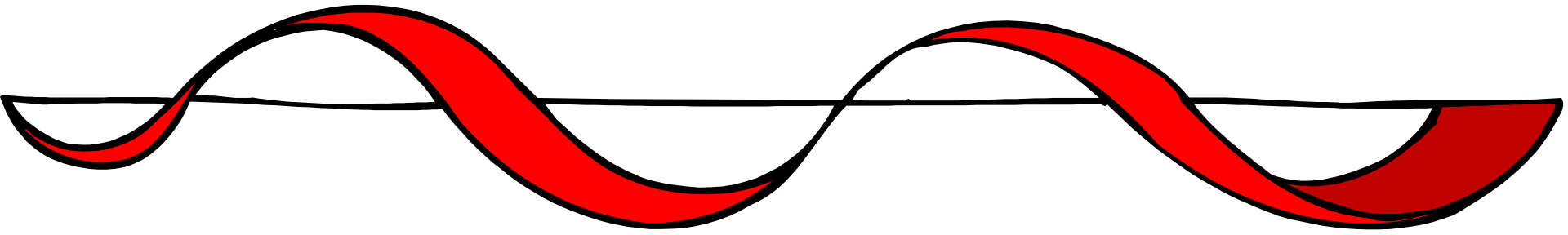
