


Theme dress days are NOT FREE DRESS DAYS! All students not participating are to be in school uniform.


Students who are participating must follow the theme guidelines listed for that theme day.



Students wear Red Clothing.




Majority of clothing item must be red. Non-red clothing items must comply with uniform policy.
