SESSION #5

Topic: Bullying/Youth Violence

Time Required: 35minutes

Objective:

Students will learn about common views of bullying, causes of bullying and ways to handle bullying.

Activity Statement:

Students will discuss the common views, causes of, and ways to handle bullying.

Materials Needed:

- Chalkboard/Whiteboard, Poster board

Procedure:

1. Brainstorm with students a list of causes of bullying. Post on board.
2. Brainstorm ways to avoid bullying. Post on board.

Discussion Questions:

1. How does bullying make the target feel?
2. Who can you turn to if you feel you're being bullied?
3. Why are people afraid to report bullying?
4. What are some ways to respond to a bully?

Closure:

In spite of the significant impact that bullying can have on a target, it often continues. There are many misperceptions that people have, all of which can lead to increasing this behavior.
