

Bylaws of the Board

Filling Vacancies

Any vacancy on the Board of Education, from whatever cause arising, shall be filled by appointment by the Board of Selectmen for the balance of the term for which the person vacating the office had been elected. Any person so appointed shall be a member of the same party as that which the vacating member represented and take office as provided for in the Charter.

Board member resignations shall be in writing and should be submitted, when possible, at a Board meeting at least thirty days prior to the effective date of the resignation.

The Chairperson of the Board of Education shall immediately notify the Town Clerk and the Chairperson of the appropriate political party of any vacancies on the Board of Education.
