- 4. Level changes are subject to availability and are permitted only during the 1st quarter.

How to register for high school classes

 Use the 8-period guide below to 'map out' your first year at TWHS. Be sure to select BOTH semesters when you choose a 1.0 credit class. REMEMBER, THIS WILL NOT BE THE ORDER OF YOUR CLASSES IN THE FALL. IT IS NOT YOUR SCHEDULE. This is simply a guide to ensure you do not schedule too many or too few classes in Infinite Campus.

- Now enter your course selections on your Registration Worksheet.
 The registration worksheet is divided into departmental sections.
 Select your required courses and electives from the available courses in each department. Note: A "P" indicates a prerequisite course is necessary.
- Log into Infinite Campus using your student log-in. Choose "Course Registration: 22-23 Thomas Worthington High School." Then click on "Course Search."
- You will see courses for which your current teachers have already recommended you take. These should be your core academic courses. Your task is to now select your elective courses.
- 5. Click "GO" and you will see the list of all the courses offered at TWHS. Scroll down until you find the course for which you wish to register. Click once on the course and you should see a description pop up below. If you wish to select this course, click "Request this Course".
- 6. Be sure to register for 3 alternative courses (courses you wish to take if we are unable to schedule all of your original requests). Follow the same process as above, but click on "Request as an Alternate" below the course description.
