Grade Level	Requirements for Promotion
Grade 9	Promoted from 8th grade
Grade 10	6 credits including English 1
Grade 11	13 credits including English 2
Grade 12	20 credits including English 3

Future Ready Course of Study

English	4 credits	English I, II, III, IV
Math	4 credits	Math I, II, and III. Last Math course to be aligned with the student's post high school plans
Science	3 credits	Earth and Environmental Science, Biology, Physical/Chemistry/Physics
Social Studies	4 credits	World History, Civic Literacy, American History, Economics and Personal Finance
Foreign Language	2 credits	*Required for university
Health/PE	1 credit	
Electives	10 credits	*At least 6 must come from CTE, JROTC, Fine Arts, or academic electives
Total Credits	28	Could be up to 32!

*Student took prerequisite in middle school

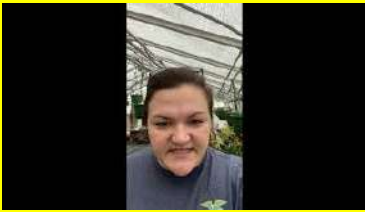
GPA/Academic Difficulty of Courses

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- **Grade Point Average (GPA)** is the numerical average of all grades for all courses taken in high school.
- **College Prep:** This is the basic level class a student can take
 - Have a maximum weight of 4.0 towards a student's GPA
- **Honors:** Students are recommended based on previous performance and teacher recommendation
 - Offered in each core subject area and open to students in all grades
 - Carries a maximum weight of 4.5 towards a student's GPA

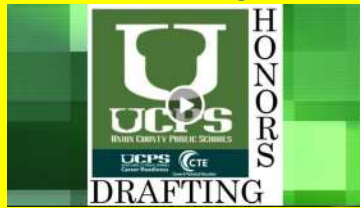
