Dear Parents and Graduating Class of 2026:

We would like to welcome you to the Husky Family. Mark your calendars and plan to join us for our orientation and showcase being planned to help get you and your incoming Freshman student familiar with Chino Hills High School.

Our first event is on Wednesday, February 2nd, from 5:30pm to 7:30pm. We will have the **Academics**, **Athletics & Activities Showcase** presentations via Zoom. This event will introduce you to our administration and you will hear about expectations, academic and specialty classes, and various programs. Counselors will also be discussing generic course request selection, graduation requirements and college entrance requirements. Students and parents are asked to log in together and take notes as we present valuable information about becoming a successful Husky student. It is highly recommended that one parent and the incoming 9th grade student attend this event. Specifics for the Health Science Academy (HSA), Business Academy of Hospitality and Tourism (BAHT), and Advancement via Individual Determination (AVID) will be discussed along with information pertaining to the application deadline. The evening will include information for you and your student about Foreign Languages, Choir, Theatre, Publications/Media Studies and much more.

Our second event for incoming freshman students will be an **individual course selection meeting** with their counselor at the junior high school. Prior to meeting with 9th graders, students and parents are asked to view the instructional video posted on our school website by visiting https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=SJhoNvSzyL4. Students are requested to select their courses for 9th grade prior to meeting with a counselor. When counselors meet with the incoming freshman *during the first week of April 2022 (CalAero on April 5th and Townsend on April 13th & 14th)*, course selection will be finalized. It is important the student brings their school-issued Chromebook to school during these scheduling days. Be advised counselors will make final course placement based upon past academic performance and testing information. Also note high school counselors will not be available to meet with incoming 9th grade students after their initial course selection meeting. Students can address any course selection changes when they visit CHHS on their registration day in late July/early August.

The third event will be the **Freshman Extra-Curricular Orientation** scheduled on Saturday, April 9, 2022, from 9am to 11am. On this date, students will have an opportunity to see the many clubs and organizations available for participation. Tours of the school campus will also be available as everyone comes together in the "Center Ice" quad.

We look forward to students attending these important events as we welcome the Class of 2026 to Chino Hills High School.
