How to Join!



Eligibility To Join and To Stay



- By the time of graduation, take 5 AP classes and *pass the class*
- Attend all meetings through the year (Students may be excused if other issues arrive)
- Be present at least 2 MAP events per year
- Pass “entrance exam”
- No D’s or F’s
- Maintain an overall GPA of 3.6
- No cheating/plagiarism
- Can join end of 8th, 9th, and 10th.

Entrance Exam:



- In this “exam” we ask students to answer questions about *themselves* and their personal life experience. Instead of focusing on academics, we want to accept and encourage students who are well rounded. We want the person, not just the student.

We Know....



- We know this can seem overwhelming. It is not unusual for straight A students to earn their first B or C upon entering high school and MAP, while they adjust to the more demanding requirements of AP and high school courses.
- Students WILL ADJUST! It just takes time management and extra effort.
- AP courses are more difficult than honors or college prep courses as they are actual college level classes.
- BUT! MAP is the solution! We help with the adjusting period, and help connect students with tutors, study groups, or other advice!

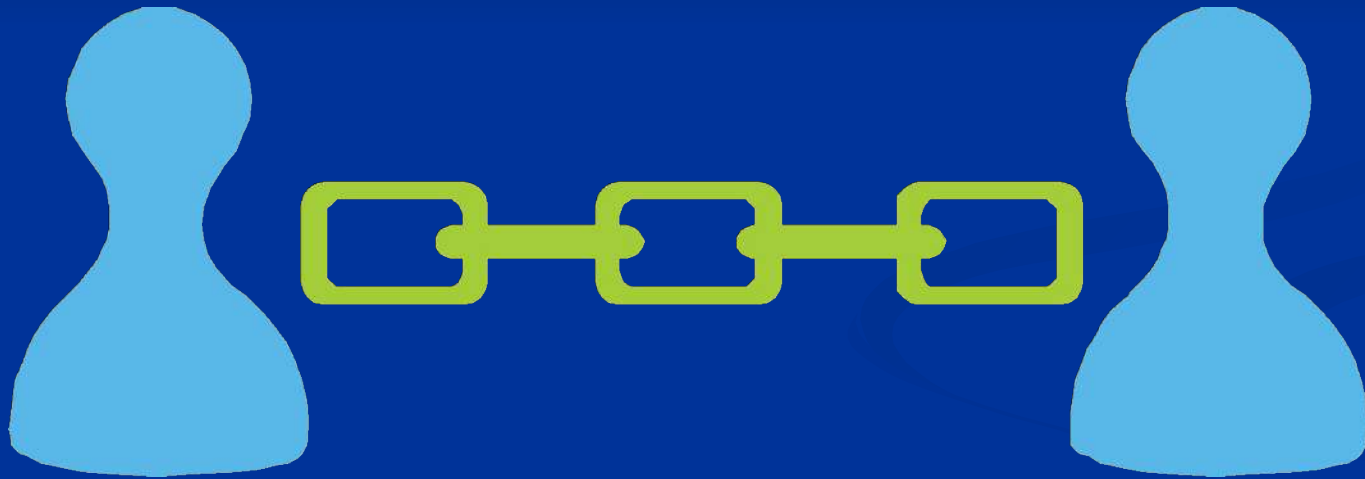

a-g Subject Requirements

Applicants must complete a specific set of 15 college preparatory courses to be eligible for admission to the California State University and the University of California. **11 of the 15 UC required college preparatory (“a-g” courses) completed by the end of 11th grade.**

Each course needs to be completed with a grade of ‘C’ or better.

a. Social Science – Two Years One year of world history, cultures and historical geography and one year of U.S. history, or one-half year of U.S. history and one-half year of American government or civics.				
b. English – Four Years College preparatory English that integrates reading of classic and modern literature, frequent and regular writing, and practice listening and speaking..				
c. Mathematics – Three Years (Four Years Recommended) Algebra 1 (Integrated Math 1), Geometry (Integrated Math 2), Algebra II, and Advanced math. Courses taken in 7 th and 8 th grades may be considered.				
d. Laboratory Science – Two Years Laboratory science providing fundamental knowledge in at least two of the three disciplines of biology, chemistry and physics.				
e. Language Other Than English – Two Years in the same language - College prep language courses taken in 7 th and 8 th grade may be included.				
f. Visual and Performing Arts – One Year Dance, music, theater or the visual arts..				
g. College-Preparatory Electives – One Year Any additional courses (not previously listed) included in the UC “a – g” list.				

Honors and AP Courses

- Honors Courses - rigorous HS level courses designed to prepare students for the pace and complexity of college level courses (AP)
- Advanced Placement (AP) courses - fast-paced college level courses that prepare students for an AP exam in May which may give college credits/waive courses
- ➔ Successful students typically have at least a 3.5 GPA
- ➔ Mandatory Summer Reading/Assignments
- ➔ Attend the AP meeting/Honors meeting in April/May
 - ◆ Check school website, Student Bulletin, Middle School Google Classroom, check @mayfaircounseling IG & FB, ask 8th grade English/History teachers

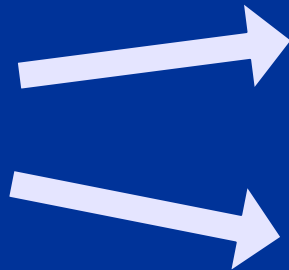
