
We Know....







a-g Subject Requirements

Applicants must complete a specific set of 15 college preparatory courses to be eligible for admission to the California State University and the University of California. 11 of the 15 UC required college preparatory ("a-g" courses) completed by the end of 11th grade. Each course needs to be completed with a grade of 'C' or better.

Honors and AP Courses

- Honors Courses rigorous HS level courses designed to prepare students for the pace and complexity of college level courses (AP)
- Advanced Placement (AP) courses fast-paced college level courses that prepare students for an AP exam in May which may give college credits/waive courses
- Successful students typically have at least a 3.5 GPA
- Mandatory Summer Reading/Assignments
- Attend the AP meeting/Honors meeting in April/May


