- Two years of the same world language

f. VISUAL AND PERFORMING ARTS (VPA) 1 YEAR REQUIRED

- A yearlong approved arts course from a single VPA discipline.

g. ELECTIVES 1 YEAR REQUIRED

- One year (two semesters), in addition to those required in "a-f" above.

“a-g” Subject Requirements

Applicants must complete a specific set of 15 college preparatory courses to be eligible for admission to the California State University and the University of California. **11 of the 15 UC required college preparatory (“a-g” courses) completed by the end of 11th grade.**

Each course needs to be completed with a grade of ‘C’ or better.

THE “a-g” SUBJECT REQUIREMENTS					
a. Social Science – Two Years One year of World History and one year of US History or Government					
b. English – Four Years Composition and literature designated as college preparatory.					
c. Mathematics – Three Years (Four Years Recommended) Algebra 1/Integrated Math 1, Geometry/Integrated Math 2, Algebra II/Integrated Math 3, and Advanced math. Courses taken in 7 th and 8 th grades may be considered.					
d. Laboratory Science – Two Years At least one biological laboratory science and one physical laboratory science.					
e. Language Other Than English – Two Years in the same language - College prep language courses taken in 7 th and 8 th grade may be included.					
f. Visual and Performing Arts – One Year Art, dance, theater/drama, music.					
g. College-Preparatory Electives – One Year Any additional courses (not previously listed) that are included in the UC “a – g” list.

Honors and AP Courses

- Honors Courses - rigorous HS level courses designed to prepare students for the pace and complexity of college level courses (AP)
- Advanced Placement (AP) courses - fast-paced college level courses that prepare students for an AP exam in May which may give college credits

- Successful students typically have at least a 3.5 GPA
- Mandatory Summer Reading/Assignments
- Attend the AP meeting/Honors meeting in April/May

Summer Homework Reading -- The Bildungsroman

A bildungsroman (German: “formation novel”) is a literary genre that focuses on the psychological development of a young protagonist. Also known as a “coming of age” novel, these stories generally begin with an intelligent yet naïve boy or girl and follows that character’s development into a mature, more knowledgeable adult. Hence, they “come of age” throughout the book. Each of these titles teaches readers something important about life and encourages one to learn from mistakes through perseverance.

For your summer homework reading assignment, **you must choose one of the following novels to read and annotate over the summer.** A separate graphic organizer for the novel of your choice will be posted in the summer homework Google Classroom and should be completed and submitted to the Google Classroom by the first day of school. Additionally, you will take a writing assessment on your novel during the first week of school. If you decide to take Honors English 9, you will choose a second novel to read for independent reading during the first quarter on SSR Mondays.

In an effort to incorporate more 21st Century Literature, some of these titles may contain mature language, events, or themes. Please research these titles to find the best option that you and your parents agree is the right book for you. 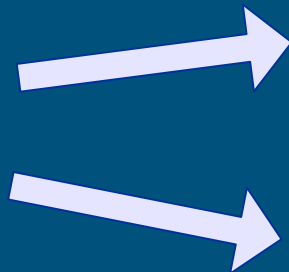
