
- South Carolina Public Colleges/Universities

College Requirements

- Clemson University requires 3 units of the same foreign language.

- Students looking at out of state institutions should check with that institution on what it requires.



OPEN AM 1 or 7 periods??

- Open AM 1 A 9th grader's school day begins at 9:06 AM and ends at 3:45 PM. (*Students may ride the bus in the morning and also in the afternoon*.) Students take 6 courses with this schedule. All 9th graders have this included with their course requests.
 - The RHS administration may offer an optional 1st period to freshmen who want to take 7 classes per day (8:15AM 3:45PM). If a freshman has his/her own transportation to school and wants to take a 1st period class, the student should select one additional elective from the list.
 - If teacher allotments and the master schedule allow for all freshmen requests, the 1st period requests will be honored. A final decision will be mailed in June.






Important Registration Dates

- Weeks of February 22nd and March 7th counselors met with middle school teachers to discuss RHS curriculum. We gave them characteristics and test scores to consider when making recommendations for RHS' three levels of instruction. We encouraged them to look at test grade averages when making recommendations. Those (not homework and projects) are the best indicators of how much a student knows.
- Week of March 7th counselors met with middle school students and distributed RED folders. We reviewed RHS courses and levels.
- Weeks of February 29th and March 7th middle school teachers make recommendations
- Weeks of March 7th and March 14th middle school students see recommendations online and select other courses


