What is the day like at HRHS?

- Block Schedule
 - 4 Classes a day, per semester
 - 8 Classes per school year
 - 1 credit is earned for every class passed at the end of the semester
 - Each class is 90 minutes





How is high school different from middle school?

- More Choices, More Responsibility
- Lockers are by request only \$5.00 for a lock
- Bookbags can be carried from class to class
- HRHS starts 7:15am and end at 2:15pm
- Students must earn at least 6 credits to move on to 10th grade

Attendance is VERY Important in High School

Attendance is taken each class period


If you are tardy 4 times in the same class, it equals 1 absence

8 or more class periods missed may result in **no credit** regardless of grade in class

If you are absent, bring an excuse note and turn in all missed assignments

High School Exams

- End of Course (EOC) tests are required for:
 - Math I
 - Math III
 - Biology
 - English II
- All classes have a final exam that counts for 25% of the final average





Graduation Requirements

• 27 credits are required to graduate

ENGLISH: 4 credits

MATH: 4 credits

SOCIAL STUDIES: 4 credits

SCIENCE: 3 credits

HEALTH & PE: 1 credit

• ELECTIVES: 11 credits

 High school credits earned while in Middle School count towards total number of credits for graduation, <u>but are not calculated in your GPA</u>

Other Requirements



9th graders must pass 6 of their 8 classes to enter 10th grade



To play a sport, student-athletes must pass 3 out of 4 classes in the previous semester

*All 9th Graders playing a Fall sport are eligible.



To earn your learner's permit or driver's license, you must pass 3 out of 4 classes in the previous semester Students' driver's licenses can be revoked if they do not pass 3 out of 4 classes each semester

Registering for classes...

Regular Classes:

 Cover content outlined in the curriculum for each subject area

Honors Classes:

 Offer the same curriculum as regular classes, but are tailored for high-achieving students covering additional topics or content in greater depth

Honors or Regular?

- Choose the level that you are ready for. Honors can increase your GPA, but only if you do well in the course.
- Honors is right for the student who:
 - Manages long-term assignments and tasks
 - · Expresses ideas clearly and correctly in writing
 - Is a motivated, hard worker
 - Works well independently
 - Enjoys being challenged academically





Choices for Next Year

English:

- English I
- Honors English I if making an A or B in 8th grade ELA

Math:

- Math I
- Honors Math I if making an A or B in 8th grade Math
- · Honors Math II if currently in Math I
- Honors Math III if currently in Math II

Science:

- Earth Environmental Science if currently in 8th grade Science
- Honors EES if currently maintaining an A or B in 8th grade Science
- Honors Biology if currently maintaining an A or B in EES and preferably if already in Math I in 8th grade

Social Studies:

- Civic Literacy
- Honors Civic Literacy if making an A or B in 8th grade SS

Electives

- Health & PE (required)
- 3 other electives

Choices for Next Year

World Language classes are not required for high school graduation, but 2 classes of the same world language are required to be admitted to four-year colleges(ex. Spanish I & II)

We offer Spanish I or French I – pre-requisite: 80% or higher in 8th grade Language Arts

Colleges tell us they like to see a World Language in Senior year of HS, so you do not have to take a World Language yet

Academy of Finance Technology

- If you have applied to and accepted a seat in the FinTech Academy, you can find information about the program on our main HRHS webpage
- The classes you will be taking as a freshman for the academy will not be listed as choices in PowerSchool for you to pick.

How to Register for Classes

- There is a "How to Register in PowerSchool" video available as well as written step by step directions
 - The HRHS registration window opens March 15th 19th
 - HRHS school counselors will visit 8th graders at their middle schools March 15th, 16th, or 17th
- Students who register for a class but do not meet the pre-reqs, will be placed in the regular class, unless an Advance Course Commitment Form is completed & turned in to the high school counselor.
- There is also an advisement video about classes, the list of courses, a four-year plan and lots of great information to help you with your choices.
