Pick your science. Most students take Biology. If you are in higher level of math you can take Chemistry+

World Language can be one of your electives. You can choose Spanish or American Sign Language/ASL.

Everyone in 9th grade takes PE 1.

After you have picked English, Math, Science, & PE, you can pick two electives.

Then you MUST pick three alternates for the electives in case your first choice doesn't work.
