# AVID Support-

## Green Sheet aka Academic Improvement Plan

- Grades below 73%-  
Student is expected to attend tutoring for 1 hr/week for D/F grade & 30 min/week for 70-72%
- Tutoring
  - college tutor Tues & Thur before school & at lunch
  - ask individual teacher
  - use Tutor or Paper on ClassLink (free! 24/7)
  - after school, NHS hosts occasionally
  - private (communicate with teacher)

- No N's or U's**

# College Tours

\*varies each year

- **9<sup>th</sup> - 11th grades: UCR, CSUSB, CSUF, UCI**

- **12<sup>th</sup> grade: Cal Poly Pomona & Mt. SAC,**  
**possibly CSUF or UCR**

# G.P.A. Expectations

- **9<sup>th</sup> grade 2.0 or higher**
- **10<sup>th</sup> grade 2.5 or higher**
- **11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> grades 3.0 or higher**

# Other Expectations

- **Excellent behavior**
- **Extracurricular Activities (sports, clubs, church, job, intern, etc.)**
- **Volunteer**
- **Rigorous course (AP in 11<sup>th</sup> and/or 12<sup>th</sup>)**
- **Leadership role**

# Eligibility Expectations

**\*By the start of day 1 of:**

**10<sup>th</sup> grade, you cannot have more than 4  
semester D/F ineligible grades**

**11<sup>th</sup> grade you cannot have more than 3  
semester D/F ineligible grades**

**12<sup>th</sup> grade you cannot have more than 2  
semester D/F ineligible grades**

# Making up classes w/ D's & F's

- **Summer- On site (at Ayala or CHH)- free; if there's room; prioritized by grade level**
- **Summer online- you pay**
- **During year- credit recovery; prioritized by grade level \*NCAA has to be online**
