Vision

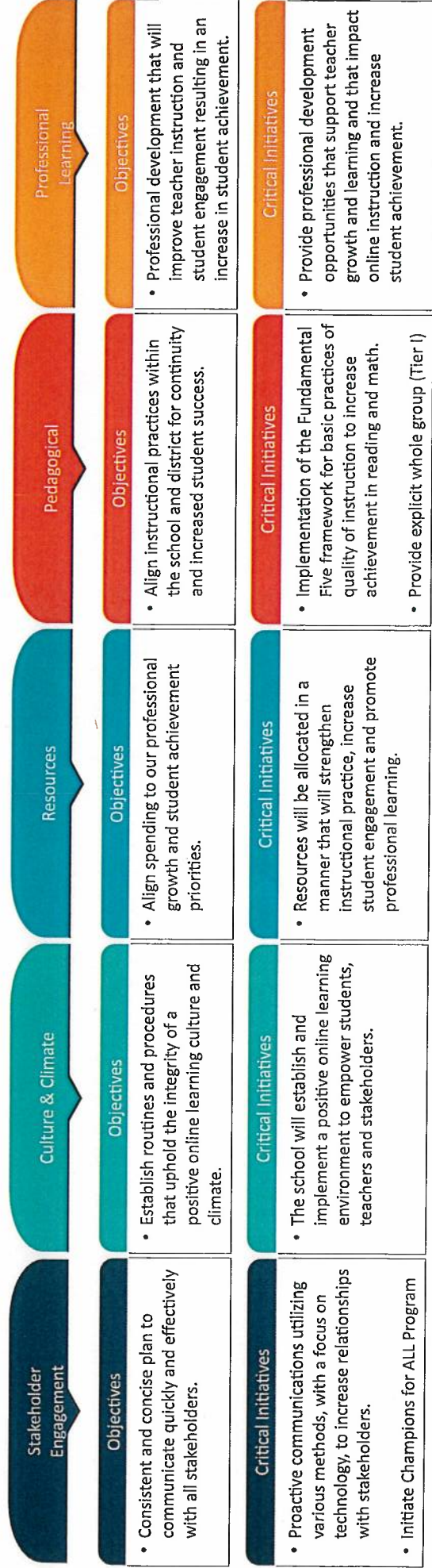
Dothan City Virtual School's goal is to prepare all students to participate productively and responsibly in a rapidly changing society.
