

School District Core Values

The core values are a set of guiding principles that serve to inform decisions throughout the school district, day-to-day and year-by-year. The Board of Education considers the following statements as core to achieving the District's mission and vision.

1. The District will work alongside the Monte Vista Community to ensure that all children enter kindergarten ready to learn.
2. The District will work alongside the Monte Vista Community to ensure that every adult will be literate and possess the necessary skills to be a productive and civic-minded member of society.
3. The District will strive to achieve a high school graduation rate of more than 90% for all groups.
4. Every school will be free of drugs and violence and will offer a disciplined, but restorative environment conducive to learning.
5. Every graduate will be literate and will possess the knowledge and skills necessary to compete in a global economy and exercise the rights and responsibilities of citizenship including civic-engagement.
6. Students will demonstrate cultural sensitivity and healthy interpersonal relationships through respect for themselves and others.
7. Students at every level must demonstrate competency in traditional academic subject matter including English, mathematics, science, history, geography, and computer and information technology.
8. The District will provide resources and opportunities for students at all levels to explore, study, and/or compete in a wide variety of disciplines and activities including music; the arts; foreign languages; physical and emotional health and wellness; business; technology; and athletics.
9. The District will strive to create understanding of healthy family relationships, child development, and personal financial responsibility.
