Daily Expectations:

Guidelines for tutoring:

- ◆ I am willing to assist any student who feels the need for extra help. However, if a student is not utilizing class time wisely, then the student will be limited or denied tutorial time.
- ◆ Please come to help sessions prepared with specific questions from attempted problems.
- ◆ **It is best if you seek extra help as soon as you find you are having difficulty** with homework. Usually, most problems can be resolved within 5-10 minutes.

Make-Up Work:

When you return from an absence, you will be responsible for the following:

- ◆ Turning in any homework that was due the day of your absence
- ◆ Copy notes from another classmate that were taken during your absence
- ◆ Getting the homework assignment(s) you missed
- ◆ Turning in your makeup work

All students are allowed to makeup missed assignments due to an absence. However, according to JHS school policy, **only students who have an excused absence will receive a grade. Unexcused absences will receive a grade of 0. All makeup test will be scheduled for 6:30 am. If you miss your appointment, you will receive a 0.** A student who misses review day (the day before a scheduled test) will take the test in class as scheduled. If you are absent multiple days, you will have as many days as you were absent to make up the test.
