Maintaining Civility at Public Meetings

There have been an unprecedented number of situations around the country, and in Connecticut, where boards of education have faced disruptions to their public meetings. In some cases, the board has been forced to adjourn the meeting without conducting the business of the board, or has required a police presence to ensure the safety of the board members and staff. The issues that prompted the disruptions are many, with decisions about local mask requirements, curriculum issues, and social and emotional support for students among the most prevalent issues.

Policy Implications

Most boards of education have bylaws or policies that address the protocol for public participation at board meetings. These policies set out the general parameters, such as the length of time that an individual may speak, and the need for civility and respectful conduct. Some boards provide for public participation at the beginning of the meeting related to agenda items, and a second opportunity at the end of the meeting to comment on other educational issues. Several samples are available <u>here</u>.

Additional Resources

The Chair of the board of education plays a critical role in setting the tone that promotes civility in the board's meeting room. Other members of the board play an important role in supporting the efforts of the Chair to de-escalate conflicts and maintain civility.

The following tips can help all board members maintain a civil atmosphere in public meetings:

speaking in a calm, firm voice to promote confidence and respect maintain neutral facial expressions and body language (even while wearing a mask as rolling of eyes can be seen)

engage in active listening when members of the public or fellow board members are speaking

resist engaging in a conversation with a speaker during public comment. Staff will follow up to address any specific concerns.

Some boards of education read a statement at the beginning of each board meeting describing the role of the board, the mission of the school district and the protocol for public comment. Samples of such a statement are available <u>here</u>.
