ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The scholarship applicant must meet the following criteria and include all requested information with the application:

- High school senior enrolled in schools located in Riverside or San Bernardino counties
- Plans to attend a four-year college or university as a full-time student as verified by the institution
- Have a minimum cumulative weighted GPA of 3.0
- Be engaged in school and/or community activities
- Submit written verification of community service hours and monthly average
- Submit an official, sealed transcript
- Submit 2 signed letters of recommendation, **one of which MUST be from a school counselor or instructor**
- Write a brief biographical essay including educational aspirations, career goals, interests and / or hobbies
- Proof of completion of Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA-www.fafsa.gov) with EFC confirmation page
- Submit a 3 x 5 photograph.

All documents must be completed and submitted together to be considered by the Scholarship Committee.
