## **Unit Focus**

In this unit, students will develop a sense of self by exploring their similarities and differences with others (e.g., family, friends, classmates). They will also learn how to be a member of a community outside of their home. Students will begin to learn about ways in which people work in the community such as farmers and construction workers. Learning will take place in a variety of instructional formats and structures including center time, table time, morning meeting, learning stations, and read aloud/second circle. Student progress will be continually monitored through observation and analysis of student work, performance, and participation. Primary instructional materials for the unit include the TeachTown Social Skills Program.
