# Dad's First Day

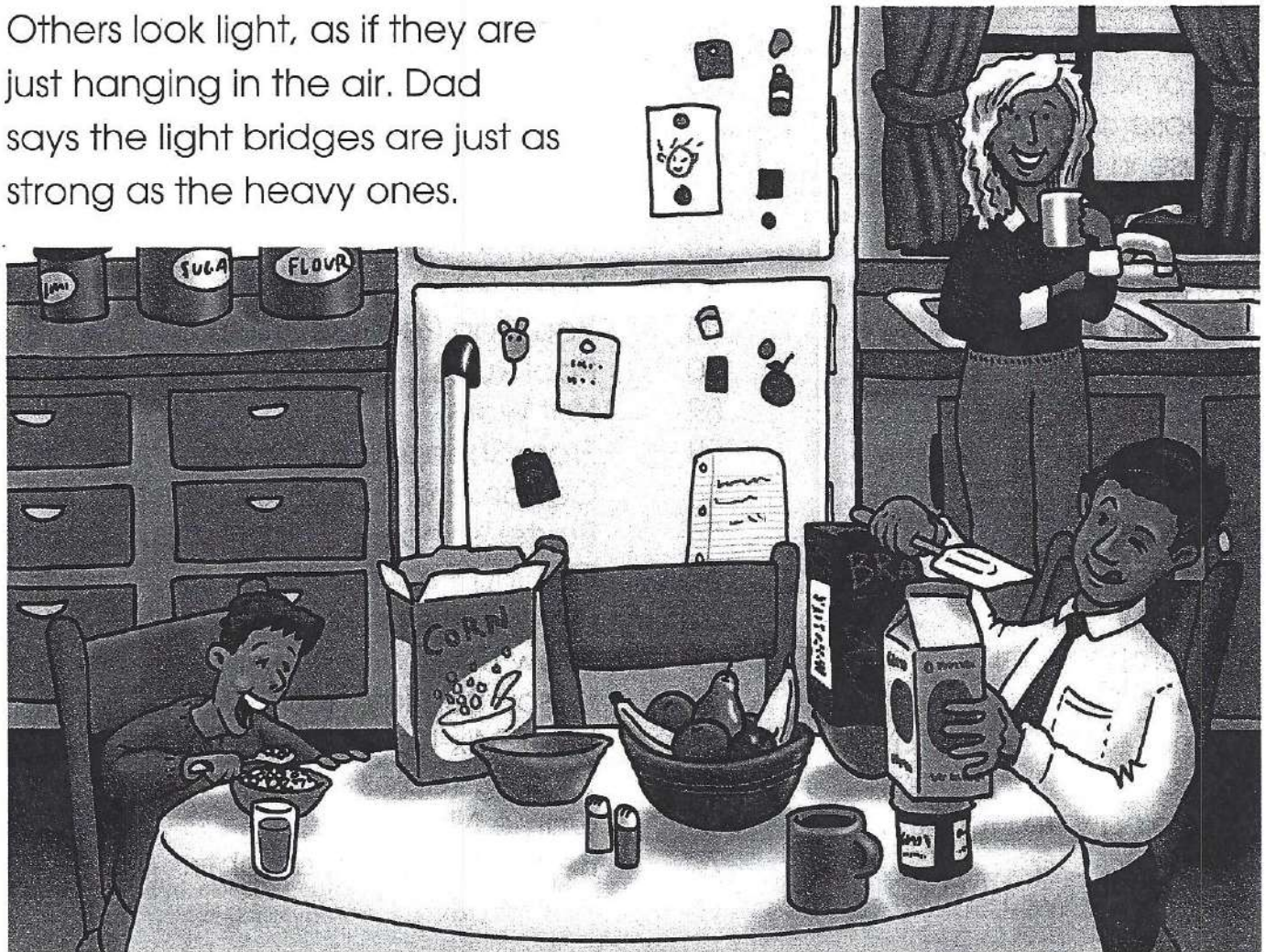
*Read to see why Dad is upset.*

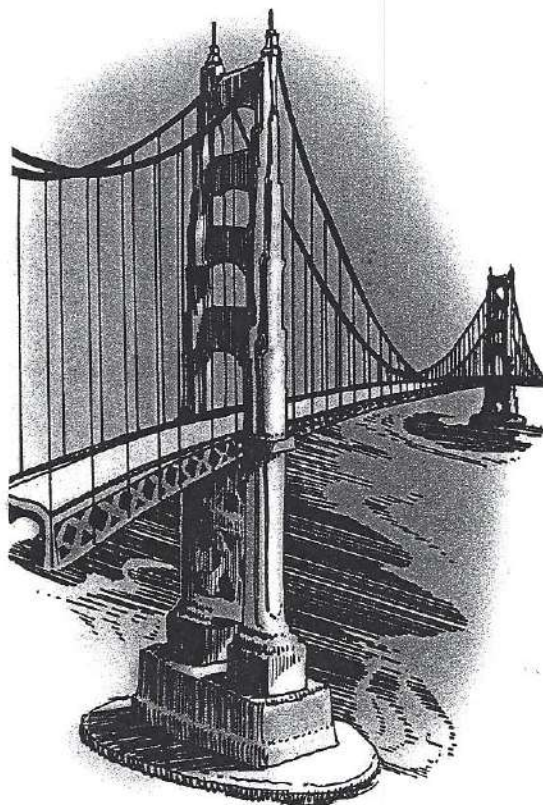

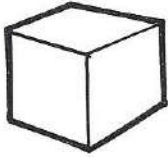


