#### ANDY AND SUZIE COOK, FAMILY HEALTHCARE EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

### APPLICATION INFORMATION DOCUMENT

The 2021 Andy and Suzie Cook Family Educational Scholarship is once again proud to be able to partner with Gadsden City High School and it's students in awarding a \$1000 scholarship to two graduating GADSDEN CITY HIGH SCHOOL seniors who have applied for, are deserving of, and have been chosen to receive these individual one-time \$1000.00 scholarships.

Founders, Andy and Suzie Cook, who have both attended college, raised a family, all while working many years in the field of senior healthcare (long term care, assisted and independent living) recognize that expenses related to various levels of post high school education, whether attending vocational college or a traditional two-year or a four-year college could be prohibitive to many. And the extra cost of getting additional education could eliminate many deserving students of having an opportunity to attend a college of choice unless a student is able to obtain some financial assistance to help with their future collegiate goals. We recognize that every graduating student won't qualify for much needed financial assistance, and with this in mind The Andy and Suzie Cook Family Educational Scholarship Fund was established; to assist graduating students who are seriously interested in pursuing a college degree, pursuing their dreams of a secure financial future, assist in the personal preparation for a secure future where your dreams and goals become your reality, but who might not otherwise qualify for other financial scholarships.

Our main goal with the Andy and Suzie Cook Family Educational Scholarship Fund (*scholarship*) is to assist students financially who might struggle with the costs of attending educational classes after high school, but otherwise have exemplary student records and studied hard meeting our suggested GPA requirements, as they enter the next educational chapter in their lives. Our scholarship committee will heavily (primarily) consider any student who has held a verifiable salaried job(s) outside of regular hours in high school. (attach letters of recommendation by their employers)

In addition, students who will be considered would have been involved in any of the many extra-curricular activities offered in high school, or possibly would have been involved outside of school with the many community opportunities available, either as a volunteer or employee. The scholarship committee will review graduating senior students who have submitted letters of recommendation from owners/supervisors where the student has volunteered at any level providing verifiable community assistance.

### Academic qualifications:

Each applicant for consideration must present proof (\*official school transcript) that they are a graduating senior in good standing at Gadsden City High School, and that they have recorded a minimum score of at least high school 2.5 GPA (on 4.0 scale), combined with a recorded overall ACT score of 18, or recorded SAT score of 900.

Each applicant must present proof on their selected college letterhead that they have been accepted into one of the following:(1) an accredited 4 year college, (2) an accredited junior college, or (3) an acceptable technical/trade college - to be considered for this scholarship. These minimum requirements must be attached to the completed scholarship application before the application can be considered.

## Additional Rules for consideration for the Andy and Suzie Cook Family Educational Scholarship: (scholarship)

- A brief essay must be attached to this application describing your reasons for applying for this
  scholarship, your future employment goals, why you want to go to college, your defined work ethic,
  reasons for working in high school (if employed), and how any time volunteered outside of school has
  impacted your goals. Also, briefly include how your time as an high school student has impacted your
  life and life goals.
- A current picture of the applicant must accompany the application.
- Since the Cook scholarship is given by a family who has a background in senior healthcare, any
  volunteer hours served in a healthcare setting, such as a nursing home, assisted living facility, or
  specialty care facility could prove beneficial (but not necessary for consideration) to any applicant. For
  consideration by the scholarship committee, validation of any hours volunteered, number of hours
  worked, and length of service (dates) to/in these facilities is required, submitted on business letterhead,
  and made a part of this application when submitted.
- Student resume. Brief listing of any extracurricular involvement, leadership experience in high school, or community service must be listed and signatures of said person(s), (teachers, employers, supervisors) responsible for your supervision must accompany the resume for each activity or service if applicable.
- <u>Letters of recommendation required.</u> The committee would request that LOR be included from at least 3 different resources; to include (a) one high school teacher (who is currently on staff), (b) Community, church pastor or Civic leader; and (c) letters of recommendation from an owner/supervisor where you have worked or volunteered while you were in high school, or someone who might have had an influence in your life's decision to attend college.
- An independent committee will decide the finalists, and the two recipients of the annual \$1000 scholarship will be notified either by phone, regular mail, or through the principal's office of Gadsden City High School no later than <u>early May</u> of the current school year. Any and all scholarships that are awarded by the fund, and any decisions made by the <u>Andy and Suzie Cook Family Educational Scholarship</u> committee are final and made at the sole discretion of the committee.
- Any financial award given by <u>Andy and Suzie Cook Family Educational Scholarship</u> (scholarship) could
  be made payable directly to the financial office of the college or technical college selected in the
  submitted application in the name of the student awarded the scholarship at the complete discretion of
  the fund.
- Students are solely responsible for any and all content submitted, and are responsible for providing
  accurate, verifiable and factual information to the committee for consideration. All recipients are
  responsible for submitting any additional information to the committee by the deadlines posted if
  requested.
