2023 ANNA C. PETTEYS SCHOLARSHIP

The Anna C. Petteys Scholarships are awarded annually to three outstanding senior girls from public high schools located in any of the following counties: Logan, Morgan, Phillips, Sedgwick, Washington and Yuma. The scholarships may be used to pursue a bachelor's degree at four-year accredited colleges or universities in the United States. They may also be used at two-year accredited colleges or universities as a first step towards a four-year degree. The amount of the scholarship is \$6,000 per year, renewable, for a total of \$24,000 over four years.

GUIDELINES FOR APPLICANTS AND SCHOOL OFFICIALS

- Scholarship forms are to be completed by the applicant and sent to the Director of Trust Operations, Jack Petteys Memorial Foundation, PO Box 324, Brush, CO 80723.
 Application deadline is <u>March 15</u>. Applications must be <u>received at Farmers State</u> <u>Bank of Brush</u> by the deadline or they will not be considered. Being postmarked by March 15 is not acceptable.
- 2. A completed application should contain all of the following items stapled together.
 - a. Application form (to be completed by the student).
 - b. SAT/ACT scores. An <u>SAT score of 1200</u> or <u>ACT score of 25</u> is necessary to apply.
 - c. Class rank and size of graduating class.
 - d. Official transcript of high school courses and grades.
 - e. A <u>signed</u> personal, typed (in 12 pt font, please) letter from the applicant (<u>one page maximum</u>) outlining goals and objectives for the future, and giving an explanation as to her financial circumstances as they relate to attending the institution of her choice.
 - f. Two completed Personal Reference Forms with attached letters: one from school faculty, one from other than school personnel e.g. doctor, minister, neighbor, employer.
- 3. Applicants selected as finalists will be invited for personal interviews sometime in April.
- 4. The winners and their schools will be notified by May 1.
- 5. If a winner receives other annually renewable scholarships totaling more than \$3,000 per year from sources other than her college, she must choose either the Anna C. Petteys Scholarship or any other(s). One-time grants are not included in this total.
- 6. Criteria for the scholarship are U. S. citizenship, academic promise, leadership and character. (A minimum SAT score of 1200 or ACT score of 25 is necessary to apply).
