
Body Systems Review Game

- At the end, tally up how many you marked and how many your partner marked






When the level of glucose (sugar) in your blood is low, your pancreas releases a hormone called glucagon in order to raise your blood sugar levels.









This system houses white blood cells




Your brain is made up of this type of neuron








