IEP Information

- When possible IEPs will be held according to their timelines.
- IEP Meetings will be held virtually- You can participate by phone, or by video. You will be sent a link to join the meeting before the meeting starts.
- You will be sent a copy of a meeting notice via email and text (Remind)

- Please make sure that I have a good email address that you check often as this will be a main form of communication.

IEP Services

- Services during distance learning can be delivered in different ways.
- The best way for students to receive information is through direct instruction. (teacher teaching students in step by step lesson sequence in person)
- In Distance Learning the best way to do this is via video chat as we are doing now
- If video chat does not work for you, then services can be delivered via other methods, such as videos, or live chat.
- During distance learning, we will be doing all of these things.

Tentative RSP Schedule

- I will make myself available to students at specific times of the day via Google Meets. 3 days a week. The other 2 days I will be checking in digitally and providing support via Google Classroom.
- I highly encourage students to take advantage of the Google meetings as they will provide opportunity for direct instruction.
- If they cannot participate via Google Meets then Google Classroom will be their next avenue of support. In Google Classroom I will post videos and other materials that might support them with what they are learning at that time.
- There is a stream feature on Google Classroom where they can post questions and I can answer them.
