## Testing Information

RHS Parents,

The following email outlines the testing schedule for RHS this year. Please refer to this schedule to determine when your student needs to report to school during the 2-day testing window. Please note that school will be dismissed at the conclusion of PSAT and CMAS testing at RHS and only LIMITED bus routes will be available which include drop offs at Carlson Farms, Rocksbury Ridge, Clearview, Pioneer Ridge, Milliken Middle School, Settler's Village and The Mad Russian. Please arrange transportation for your student if these drop off locations are not sufficient.

### **IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING CELL PHONES DURING TESTING:**

Per College Board regulations: Students are strongly encouraged not to bring phones or other electronic devices into the testing room. If a student's phone makes noise, if the student is seen using it, or if the student is seen attempting to access it at any time, INCLUDING DURING BREAKS, he or she will be dismissed immediately, his or her scores may be cancelled, and the device may be confiscated.

### **TUESDAY APRIL 9<sup>th</sup>, 2019: 9<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Graders will NOT report at all this day**

#### **10<sup>th</sup> Graders:**

10<sup>th</sup> grade students will be taking the PSAT at RHS. Testing will conclude at 11:45 AM and students are dismissed at that time. LIMITED bus routes will be available which include drop offs at Carlson Farms, Rocksbury Ridge, Clearview, Pioneer Ridge, Milliken Middle School, Settler's Village and The Mad Russian.
