HUMAN GROWTH, DEVELOPMENT AND FAMILY LIFE EDUCATION POLICY

Any parent or legal guardian of a Waterbury Public School student may exempt his/her child from any or all lessons dealing with Human Growth, Development and Family Life portions of the Health and Wellness Education Curriculum. This may be done by **written notification** to the Principal of the building that the child attends. Copies of the curriculum are available at the school for parent review. If you would like to read the curriculum, please call the school and make an appointment to come in and review the material.



NURSE'S NOTES:

Scoliosis Screening will be done in April for 5th and 7th grade girls, and 8th grade boys. Notices have been sent home with the students. Screening will be done during grade assigned Physical Education classes.

If your child attends school with a splint, ace bandage, cast, immobilizer, or crutches, it is the parent's responsibility to present all corresponding paper work to the nurse. The nurse is not able to follow through on any restrictions unless there is documentation with instructions. No medications will be given to any child in school WITHOUT a doctor's authorization order.

Please make the doctor's appointment for your 6th graders physical and 7th grade immunizations early. Appointments fill up fast!
