In Math, we are learning about 2-D shapes and their attributes (size, color, shape, angles, sides) and 3-D shapes and their attributes (vertices, faces, edges). We are going to be able to add and subtract within 1,000!

In ELA, we have finished reading about Folktales. Our new and final unit will be called Players and Poets...we will be reading plays and learning about and creating poems.

We are looking forward to the snow leaving the grounds and having outdoor recess...and to our April Vacation. The last day of school, as of this typing, is Wednesday, the 20th of June...(thanks to the many snow days).

3RD GRADE

The end of the third marking period is rapidly approaching and the Third Grade is on full steam ahead! We are busy working on our animal projects which represent the culmination of our reading unit that focused on nonfiction texts. Our next unit will center on poetry and language; the students will have fun exploring the different ways authors express their thoughts and ideas. In Fundations we are learning more vocabulary by examining base words and root words, and how the meaning changes when we add suffixes and prefixes. In math we are wrapping up the module on fractions and will be moving onto our final module which begins with measuring lengths using ½ and ¼ inches, drawing and interpreting picture and bar graphs, and rounding numbers to the nearest 10 or 100. Please review telling time, as many third graders are still struggling with this. You can also help your child to stay fluent in the facts by practicing daily multiplication/division and addition/subtraction. Have a quiz!! Make it fun!! ***Important Reminder April is Smarter Balance Testing Month. Please be sure your child is getting a good night's sleep***
