# WONDERS SKILLS FOR THE WEEK:

- **Essential Question:** Who helps you? We will be learning about the people in our lives who help us.
  - **Vocabulary:** inspire, respect, distance, swiftly, decision
  - **Sight Words:** brother, father, friend, mother, love, picture
  - **Phonics:** variant vowel /aw/ pronounced like "claw". This is a rule with many spellings: a, aw, au, augh, al
  - **Grammar:** Possessive pronouns  
Possessive pronouns show who or what has or owns something. Example: **HIS** book is interesting. **MY** cat is white.
  - **Speaking & Listening Skills:** Retell and discuss stories.
  - **Spelling Words:** haul, cause, saw, claw, paw, dawn, moon, soup, love, friend
  - **Reading:** Nonfiction Text
  - **Writing:** Informative; Present Information

This is what it looks like in your "To Do" list once it is opened.

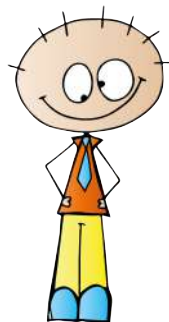
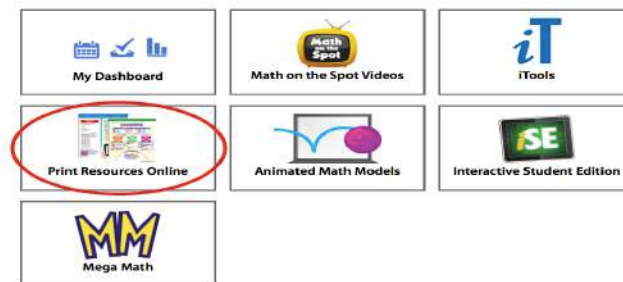


# GO MATH:
