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Art 2 continues to build on skills learned from Art 1, providing a stronger, broader, foundation for the following art courses. Students will continue to draw from direct observation of objects and live models, work with charcoal, colored pencils, chalk pastels, oil pastels acrylic paint, watercolor, pen, collage materials, and sculpture materials. *Students are asked to work very hard every day in class! They chose to take Art 2, this means they want to be here and want to produce excellent work. I have high expectations!*

### **Grading Policy:**

#### **Formal Assessment: 70% Projects**

A Rubric is followed when grading:

- Craftsmanship 25%
- Effort/Time Management 25%
- Execution of the medium at hand 25%
- General understanding of the learned concept 25%

#### **Daily Progress: 30%**

- Daily grades consist of class participation, staying on task, and giving your best effort
- Students draw every day to a story I read, which is graded on effort and completion.
- Weekly timed direct observation drawings with a variety of media-graded
- Weekly figure drawings-graded
