- Entrant must be 18 years or older
- Each entrant is limited to three (3) pieces of art work.
- All art work must be the original work of the entrant.
- Art work may be submitted as a digital photo or digitized drawing.
- Please submit art work as a .jpeg, .png, or pdf. **All art work submissions must have a resolution of at least 600 dpi and file sizes should be no larger than 20 mb to be accepted for entry.**
- Entries will be accepted no earlier than 9:30 am **Friday, July 1, 2022**, and no later than 8 p.m. **Saturday, July 30, 2022**. Art work may be submitted by email to Cheri Carpenter via email at ccarpenter@aclib.us.
- All entries **must** be accompanied by a completed *Entry Form* signed by the artist. (This *Entry Form* will serve as a release allowing the library to use and/or display the artist's work on the library website, on the library's social media pages and YouTube channel)
- Artwork will be displayed on the library's website and its social media sites i.e., Facebook, and Flickr webpages.
- A virtual art demonstration of all submitted art work will take place to kick off the art show in the first week of August.
