








# Color

✦A visual attribute of things that results from the light they emit or reflect. +Color has three properties: + Hue or tint, the color name - red, yellow, blue, etc. ✦Intensity, the purity & strength of color ✦ Value, the lightness or darkness of a color


#### Form








# Balance


The way art is arranged to create a feeling of stability in a composition






