

Art Journal Requirements

With each project (every 6 weeks) you will have a set of art journal pages due. Art journal pages must include the following. You will submit these pages after the project is finished.

- **Proposal Page:** Title it: Project #1 and whatever your project is. Example: *Project #1: Poster*. The approved proposal must be glued in. This should be the first page of each new project.
- **Research Page(s):** Title it: *Research*. Show evidence that you did some research. This will include notations of your findings such as the style, artist/designer, movement, trend, technique and anything else you find important. Glue on the page some reference examples to support your research.
- **Sketches Page(s):** Title it: *Sketches*. You must have a minimum of three sketches about $\frac{1}{4}$ page in size. Include notes, comments, reflections of your sketches. You can compare sketches to one another, write which you like best and why or any problems you see with the sketches. You can add teacher recommendations and suggestions and peer critique comments.
- **Final Artwork:** Title it: *Final Artwork*. Include a small-scale print of your final work, about $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ page in size. Glue it on the page. Write comments and reflections about the outcome; what you like/dislike about it, what you might do differently, challenges you faced, things you learned by doing your project.
- **Design:** There must be some creative design throughout the page to organize and pull the elements together. You can add color, value, cut-outs, lines, shapes etc to add interest to the page.
- **Date:** Put the date on each page in top outer corner; month-date-year you started or completed the page.
