Requirements:

- Have a grade point average of at least a "C".
- Have demonstrated qualities of good citizenship, character and integrity – may include community service, employment inside or outside of school activities.
- Have definite higher education goals.
- Portfolio – 3 to 5 pieces of art work.
- Grade transcripts.
- Personal essay, 250-500 words.
- Must present a complete application.

Please complete the application, attach transcripts, personal essay, a letter of reference regarding good citizenship and other qualities by April 1. The CAA will review each application to ensure all requirements are met. **All interviews will be scheduled for Saturday, April 6, 2019 between 10:00am and 2:00pm at the CAA, located at 815 W. 6th St, Room 145, Corona. Bring your portfolio of works to this interview.**
