WONDERS SKILLS FOR THE WEEK:

- **Essential Question:** How can weather affect us?

- **Vocabulary:** predict, cycle, creative, frigid, scorching
- **Sight Words:** been, children, month, question, their, year
- **Phonics:** Silent letters wr, kn, gn (sounds like "n")
- **Grammar:** Compound words

Compound words are two words put together to make one different word. Examples: **rainbow**, **butterfly**, **ladybug**.

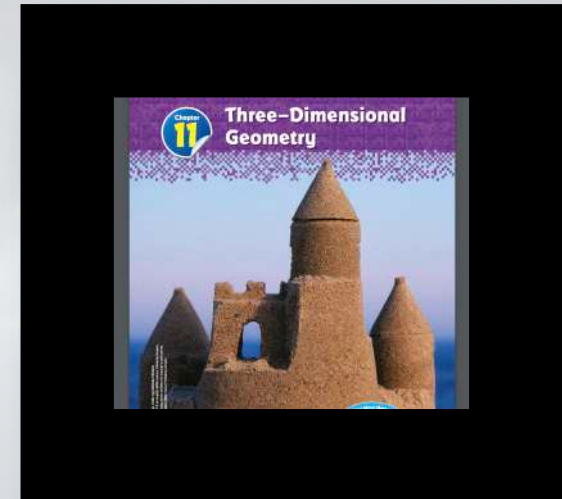
If you have the book, Frog and Toad Together, that would be a great book for you and your child to read together this week!
