♦ The climate ranges from tropical to desert.




### Diego Rivera, early life...



 While in Paris he met Pablo Picaso and worked in the style of Cubism.






♦ "Pan American Unity".  In 1921 he returns.

 Diego Rivera marries two times: Guadalupe Marin, then Frida Kahlo in 1029






