Great Falls Education Foundation Art Scholarships

Background:

The Great Falls Education Foundation has established two scholarships for students pursuing higher education in the visual arts. One scholarship will be given to a Charles M. Russell High School graduate and one will be given to a Great Falls High School graduate; students from Skyline will be alternately included with those from CMR (in even-numbered years) and those from GFHS (in odd-numbered years).



Requirements:

- 1. Must be a graduate of a Great Falls high school
- 2. Must pursue higher education in art as described below
- 3. Must submit a one page, typed, double-spaced statement addressing art and future plans
- 4. Must submit two letters of support
- 5. Must submit two matted art works no larger than 16" by 20" including mat
- 6. Must submit ten 35mm color slides of art works (ten separate works or multiple views/details of various works) in a plastic sleeve following the formatting example here:



Additional Information:

A jury consisting of one retired public school art educator, one college art educator, and one museum educator or practicing artist will be chosen by the supervision committee of the secondary art faculty. The jury will be "double blind," meaning that the names of the jurors will

not be known by the applicant and the art work of the applicants will be identified only by number.

All materials will be returned to the applicants' home schools by May 1.

The awarded scholarship will be paid directly to the accredited university, college, or art school to cover tuition with proof of enrollment in two art classes or declaration of an art major. If a student fails to meet either of these criteria in either the first or second semester of their college career the scholarship will be forfeited and the funds will remain with the Great Falls Education Foundation.
