Pop Art Project - 200pts

This project consists of two parts:

- 1. Reflective/Research Paper
- 2. Pop Art related work of art

To get familiar with the different aspects of the POP ART movement, gather information by searching the internet, going to the library, and reading books or magazine articles. Your research can be on a particular artist of the movement, historical or cultural influences, the style of art, all the above or anything you find pertinent to your understanding of the POP ART movement.

The Reflective-Research Paper: 100pts

Write a paper that reflects your research of this movement and include in the paper what, how or who in the POP ART movement inspired you to create the work of art you made. The style paper I am looking for is more of a reflective paper than a research paper. Your finished paper should present your own thinking backed up by ideas and information of the movement. If you are going to cite from a reference be sure to use proper citation.

Length: Three pages total, stapled: 2 pages typed and 1 page that includes a work of art that inspired you to create the art work you completed.

Format: 12 pt Arial or Times Roman, double spaced, Label: Student name and period, top, right corner

Title: POP ART MOVEMENT PAPER, top center, bold font, 13pt

Structure: Opening paragraph (introduction), closing paragraph (conclusion) and paragraphs in between (body)

Be sure that grammar, punctuation and spelling are correct; sentences are complete, logical, and clear.

Write the paper in your own words. Do not plagiarize by copying text word for word and do not copy and paste from the internet. <u>Papers will not be accepted if you use the exact wording from a book or reference</u>. Writing short sentences that are original is always preferable to writing long sentences with words that you cannot define.

The Art Work: 100pts

Create a work of art that reflects your research of the POP ART movement. The artwork may be created in Photoshop or Illustrator or by using a combination of the two. The work should reflect the pop art style but may be created in whatever fashion you choose. To help with ideas be sure to research various types of artwork and artists during the POP ART era.

Size: Any format that will fit on an 8.5 x 11 horizontal or vertical

Software: Photoshop or illustrator

Style: POP ART style in any fashion desired. You may use subject matter relevant to today.

Some popular artists of the POP ART movement:

Robert Rauschenberg, Jasper Johns, Andy Warhol, Roy Lichtenstein, Richard Hamilton, Peter Blake, and Claes Oldenberg.
