 - Interviews will be held at the Common Area – 2nd floor – of the Grand Theatre Center for the Arts – 715 Central Avenue starting at 10:00 am.
- **Scholarship recipient will be required to attend the Tracy Art League general meeting with a few pieces of their portfolio and discuss their work on May 12, 2022 at 7:00 pm.**

 5. Your goals in pursuing a career in the arts
 6. Your reason for applying for a scholarship
 3. A copy of your transcript.
 4. A letter of recommendation from one of your teachers.
- You will be contacted for a personal interview.
 - The scholarship committee will want to see a portfolio of at least 10% works completed within the last three years.
