
Adolescence is an emotional time for both youth and parents. Teenagers begin to assert their independence, sometimes resulting in conflict and risk-taking behavior.

Our voluntary program, Navigating the Adolescent Years, addresses substance abuse, disruptive or high-risk behaviors, & family conflict due to development issues for students ages 8-18. It's important for parents to understand the developmental stages of transition from childhood to adulthood in order to help their teens handle the rough patches smoothly.

This program provides a safe environment for teens to learn and discuss conflict management, communication, schoolwork, substance abuse, anger, depression & anxiety.


It can also be customized to include individual and family therapy, enrichment activities, educational classes, academic monitoring & tutoring, community service, & substance abuse monitoring.

Please read the following information to help you navigate through the new school year. As many of you have already noticed, the Thompson School District has a new website face so things are found in different places on LEMS website this year.

- The majority of your questions will be answered on our main web page by clicking on the right side tab "EXPLORE"/OUR SCHOOL. It contains all of the information you will need to know regarding policies/procedures. On the main webpage click on "EVENTS" for LEMS calendar of events.
- 2. "Stay Tuned In" is an important new document for Parent/Guardians-updated daily for you to stay informed of immediate news here at LEMS. (It was formerly "Information" on the old main web site) It is located on LEMS website/Explore Tab (right side)/Our School/Stay Tuned In. This document will list day-to-day communications to parents.
- 3. **Please** make sure your student always has money in their lunch accounts. In Middle School chips and drinks are offered for purchase which can reduce their account balances. To create a lunch account-go to the Thompson District main web page-follow the link "Nutritional Services" under POPULAR tab on the right side.
- 4. PLEASE print off the new updated version of LEMS Student Handbook. Again, it is located on LEMS website/Explore Tab (right side)/Our School/ Student Handbook. It contains detailed information regarding our NEW/REVISED policies/procedures for 2016-17 and will answer a lot of your questions.
- 5. Your student's assigned bus will always be in its same line-up position out in front of LEMS. Example: Bus # 1088 is **always** parked in 2nd Bus Position, Bus # 1045 is ALWAYS parked in 7th Bus position. If a student is in doubt, they can always ask the driver..."are you going to such-and-such corner". The driver is always happy to help!


