A growth mindset is the belief that you can learn anything. It is a belief that no matter how young or old you are you can learn new things. The opposite of a growth mindset is a fixed mindset, which believes that intelligence is fixed and that you are either born smart or not and that there is nothing that can be done to change it. We want all of our students to embrace a growth mindset and what is called the power of "Yet". So, when you hear your child say I'm not good at math, or art, or any other skill, remind them that they are not good at it yet; but they can always get better at everything. 
