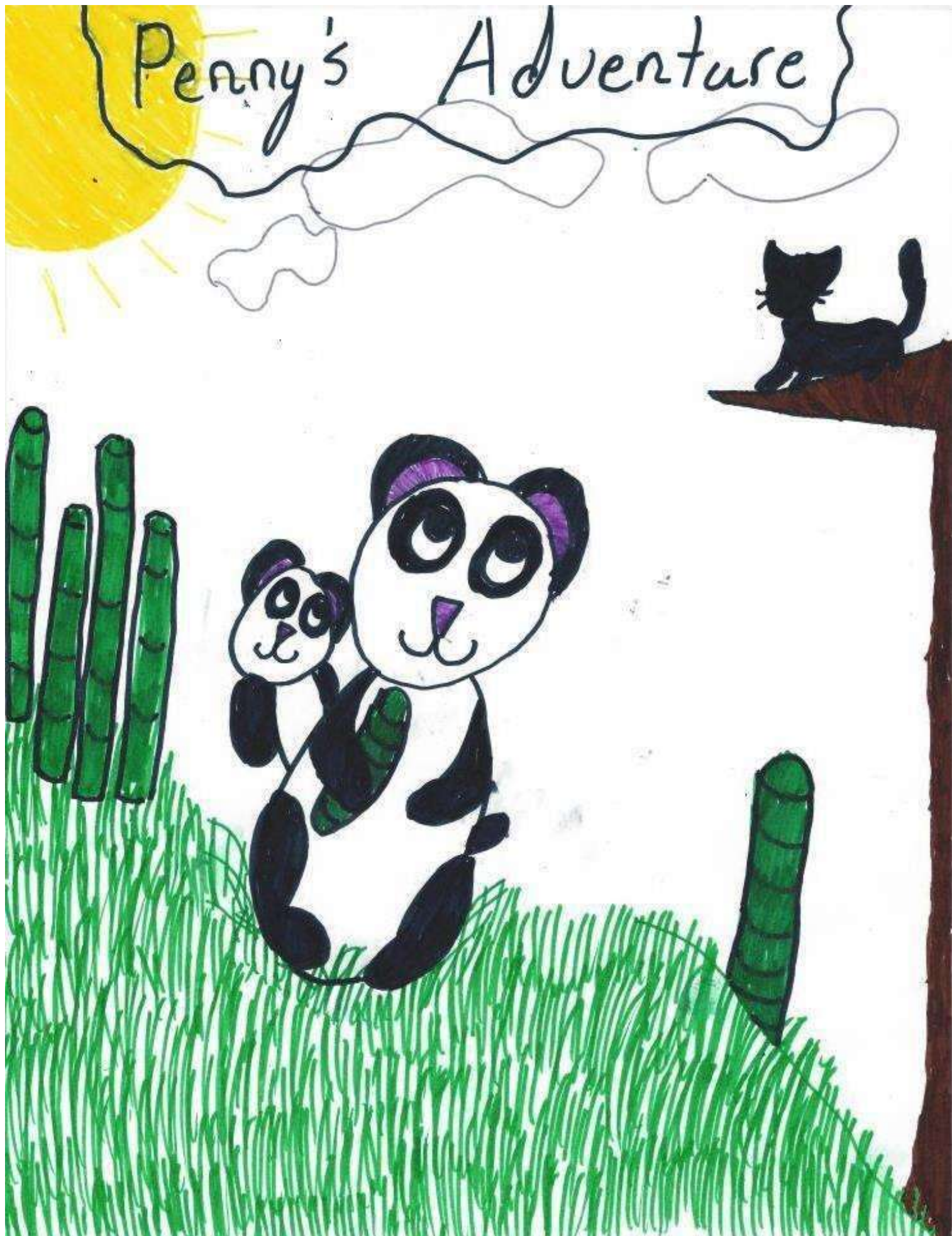


Penny's Adventure
