BACK TO SCHOOL BULLETIN

The first day of classes for students, grades 1st - 12th will be August 15th.

The first day for kindergarten will be August 22nd.

The first day for Preschool will be September 3rd.

Elementary 7:55 a.m.-3:20 p.m.; Secondary 7:50 a.m.-3:30 p.m. Buses will run and lunch will be served each day.

REGISTRATION:

***PRE-SCHOOL** – If you did not register in the spring, please call Lisa Trautwein at 483-7783.

ELEMENTARY students in grades K-6** will register on Thursday, August 1st from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. in the Elementary gym. ***Student pictures will be taken on this day, so please dress appropriately.

SECONDARY students in grades 7-12** will register on Thursday, August 1st from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. in the High School Cafeteria. ***Student pictures will be taken on this day, so please dress appropriately.

****All library fines, over-due lunch accounts and over-due athletic fees must be paid before students can register and receive their schedules****

*(After **NEW** students have registered, the principals' offices will contact the bus garage for transportation arrangements. The transportation director will then contact you as to your schedule.)*

LUNCH ACCOUNTS ARE TO BE PAID IN ADVANCE. **CHARGES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.** Information on free and reduced price meals will be given to each student at registration. **Each** family is to return **ONE** completed application to either principal's office. All application information is kept confidential.

IMMUNIZATIONS:

Immunizations are an important part of our children's health care and Colorado law requires all students attending Colorado schools and licensed child care centers to be vaccinated against certain diseases unless an exemption is filed. The following are required in order to attend a Colorado school for the 2019-20 school year. Students 4 through 6 years of age are required to have final doses of DTaP, IPV, MMR and Varicella PRIOR to kindergarten entry. 6th Graders are required to have Tdap PRIOR to entry. **ALL STUDENTS K-12 MUST HAVE 3 DOSES OF HEPATITIS B, 4 DOSES OF POLIO, 2 DOSES OF MMR, 5 DOSES OF TETANUS/DIPHThERIA/PERTUSSIS, 2 DOSES OF VARICELLA.**

ATHLETICS:

HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC FEE: \$100 for 1st sport \$50 for each after. Maximum per family \$300.

MIDDLE SCHOOL ATHLETIC FEE: \$75 for 1st sport \$30 for each after .

(Fee includes participation in up to four sports and free admission to ANY HOME athletic contest, excluding tournaments)

All athletes **MUST** have the following items turned in to the head coach **before** he/she may participate in any practice.

Forms are available from the High School Office beginning July 29th.

1. Parent permission form with proof of insurance
2. Physical form that has been signed by your family doctor
3. Athletic/activity contract signed by both athlete and parent
4. Athletic Fee

FAMILY ATHLETIC PASSES: Families may purchase a year-long athletic pass for \$250. This pass will admit up to 5 family members into ANY HOME athletic contest at no charge.

BUS ROUTES: The Transportation Department will not pickup or drop-off students who are not on the bus route schedule. For example, students will not be allowed to ride the bus to daycare or to a friend's house after school. Buses will not drive down driveways that are less than ½ mile from the designated stop. Video and audio surveillance devices are installed in all buses. Any riders on the bus are subject to recording. If there will be a change in your child's normal bus riding schedule, please contact the bus garage before 6:30 a.m. at 483-7773. The bus route schedule is posted on the school's website (www.wiggins50.k12.co.us). Also, if you have changed your physical address or do not see your route on the website, please contact the bus garage.
