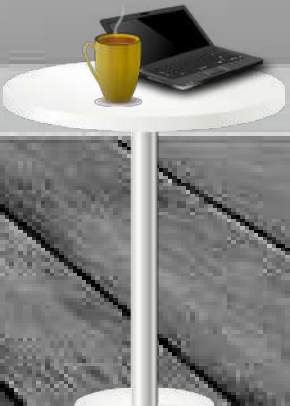

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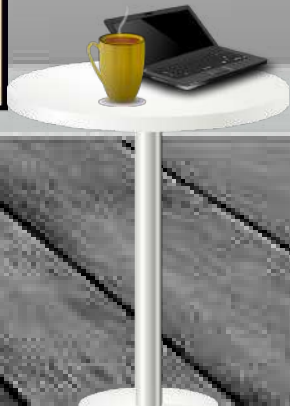

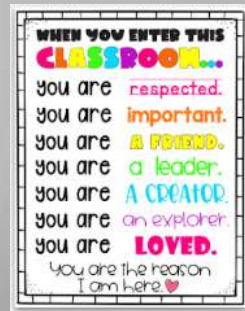


Attendance Policy



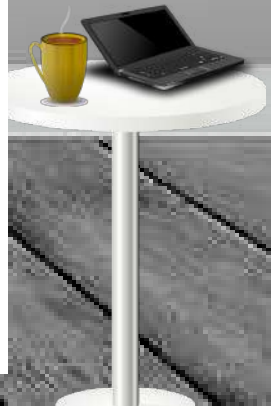
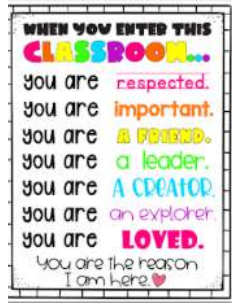
Regular attendance is important to your child's success in school. Please call the office to report an absence.

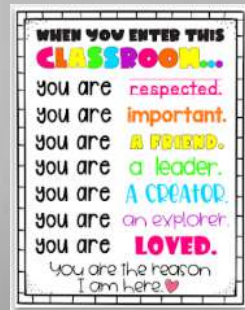

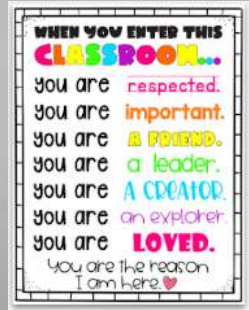

- 3- Meeting the standard
- 4- Exceeding the standard

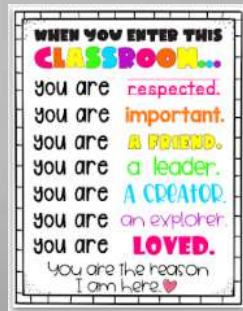

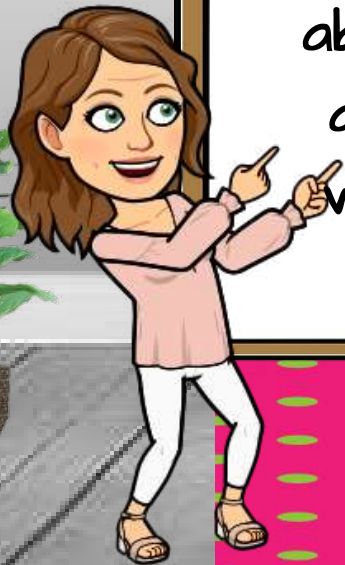

Homework Folders



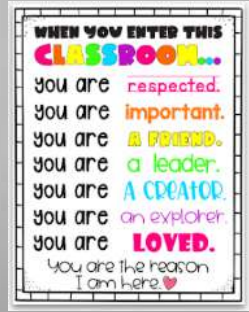

Reading Log



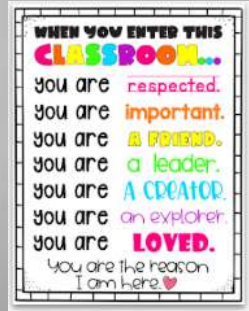

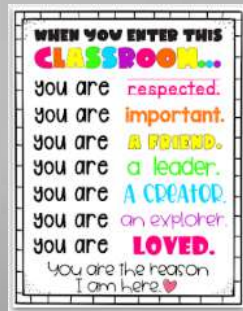
Sight words will be tested weekly. I will let you know which day of the week it will take place. Please practice these on a daily basis.

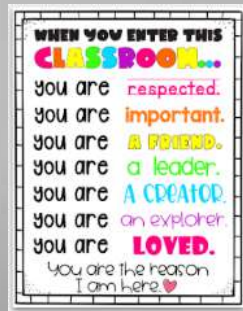

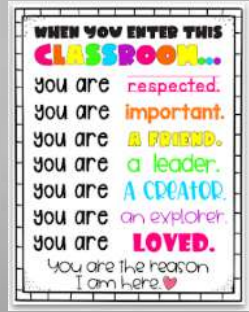

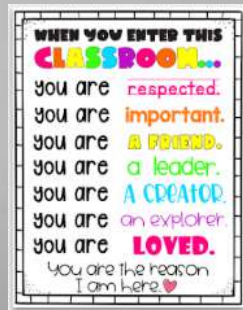

Estimation Jar



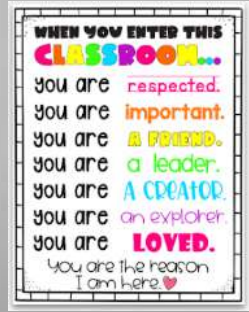
