BACTERIA WARS Trading Card (4th qt. Project)

Objective: It is your job to report to the Center for Disease Control (CDC) a background profile on the bacterial disease that you were "infected with". You will send it in the form of a trading card to the main office of the CDC in room 124 to bacteriologist Mr. Haddad.

The following items must be included on your trading card:

- Picture or hand-drawn design that illustrates the <u>SHAPE of the bacteria by itself on the FRONT of the card</u> AND picture or hand-drawn design in action on the BACK of your card (you can creatively draw it in combat) 10 PTS
- 2) Creative nickname of your bacteria (on the FRONT of card) 5 PTS
- 3) Scientific (Latin) name of your bacteria that causes the disease (on the BACK of card-spelled correctly) 5 PTS
- 4) The specific organism (living thing) that it infects 5 PTS
- 5) Parts of the body that it attacks (specific cells or organs) 5 PTS
- 6) Causes, symptoms/signs 10 PTS
- 7) Duration (amount of time) for having this disease 5 PTS
- 8) Prognosis (severity of contracting disease --- is it minor or deadly?) 5 PTS
- 9) Explanation of treatment or prevention available 5 PTS
- 10) Additional interesting information on your bacterial disease (at least 2 facts) 10 PTS
- 11) Proper heading on the BOTTOM of the backside of your trading card 5 PTS
- 12) Trading card on a 3" x 5" or 4" x 6" index card 5 PTS
- 12) Creativity in designing your trading card (designs/colors/setup/etc.) 15 PTS
- 13) Proper source citations (1-online database/print,1-picture = total 2 sources) 10 pts

*NOTE: This will be worth a 100-point special project grade (15% of final qt. 4 grade). Please don't be late in turning in your trading card on the due date. We will be having a special APRIL MADNESS trading card bracket elimination game for extra credit points on the due date so DON'T BE LATE!!! (10 point deduction for each day late)
