

**Brownsburg Community School Corporation  
Secondary Performing Arts Procedures  
for the 2020-21 School Year**

**PUBLIC PERFORMANCES**

**Middle School:**

- No Open Rehearsals with audience
- One concert event per grade level per subject for the 1st Semester, likely separated by class periods to allow for smaller groups.
  - Concerts will be recorded and/or streamed for sharing with families. The recorded and/or streamed performances will be made available at no cost due to potential copyright issues.
  - A decision on audiences will be made at a later date. If permitted, crowd will be limited due to space availability.
- The 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Musical will be moved to 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester. The musical would be cast through auditions and would include cast and chorus only, not the entire 8<sup>th</sup> grade choir.

**High School:**

- One concert per group for the 1<sup>st</sup> Semester
  - This may mean there are multiple concerts to accommodate the various groups within each subject/performing level
  - Concerts will be recorded and/or streamed for sharing with families. The recorded and/or streamed performances will be made available at no cost due to potential copyright issues.
  - A decision on audiences will be made at a later date. If permitted, crowd will be limited due to space availability.
- The Fall Musical will be moved to 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester.
  - The Spring Play can be moved to the 1<sup>st</sup> Semester with limited cast and limited audience.
- Madrigal Dinner will be different from past years. More details to follow pending conversation with BCSC Health Services Supervisor.
- Rehearsals, for all groups, outside of the school day should either be conducted outside or limited to no more than 60 minutes.

**CLASSROOM PROCEDURES**

**Middle School:**

- Instruments should be taken home to be sanitized using Sterisol (provided with each instrument rented or purchased, students may need to purchase more) once a week.
- Instruments that are shared (at the middle school this is limited to percussion) should be sanitized between different users and after each class period.
- NO sharing of instruments.
- Spread out students as much as possible (band, orchestra, and choir), use additional areas when appropriate and when supervision is available.

**High School:**

Band and Orchestra –

- Sanitize shared instruments between uses. This may occur multiple times during the school day. Students should be instructed the proper method of using Sterisol.
- All instruments, including those not shared, should be sanitized at home at a minimum of one time per week.
- Students will be spread throughout the instructional space as much as possible. This may include sections rehearsing in separate spaces.
- Students can use instrument storage area. However, this area must be monitored by staff to ensure students are moving as efficiently as possible.
- Students will wipe down chairs with an appropriate wipe before class.

Choir –

- Students will be spread throughout the instructional space as much as possible. This may include sections rehearsing in separate spaces.
- Classes of more than 30 students will be divided into 2 sections and may utilize the auditorium, piano lab, and Multi-Purpose room for instruction. Sections will be divided differently on a daily basis to give students maximum opportunity to interact and build rapport with their teachers and classmates.
- If students are not at minimum six feet apart, students will wear masks or no singing will occur.
- Students will not be sharing folders.
- Choreography will be modified to keep spacing between students and will be learned in small groups.
- Passing period entrances and exits are modified so students are not passing.
- Students will wipe down chairs with an appropriate wipe before class.
- Full ensemble singing (1-2 days per week maximum) will occur outside or in the auditorium with a minimum 6 feet between students
