Google Classroom: You will access all assignments and class-related information in our Google classroom. You can access Google classroom through Classlink. If you're having trouble, email me or check out the helpful information on my Chino High School classroom website.

Participation: You are expected to log into our Google Classroom every day. On the days that we don't have a Google Meet, there will be a question or prompt in Google Classroom for you to complete. You must complete these to get attendance credit for the days we don't have a Google Meet.

Assignments/Tests/Quizzes: As we navigate distance learning together, the assignments and timing of tests and quizzes will depend on our progression through the curriculum. I will always let you know about quizzes or tests in advance, so you have time to study and prepare.

Behavior Expectations: In our Google meet sessions, you are expected to log in at the appropriate class time, have your camera on, and mute your microphone. You can receive citizenship points in each Google meet session.
