

What is a Transcript?




4 Transcript is a document which lists:





Calculating Your GPA

- 4 <u>Example</u>: Algebra3 Biology3 Language Arts2 Physical Ed4 Elective2 Elective3 <u>Add</u> <u>together</u>= 17 <u>Divide by 6=</u> 2.83 GPA
- 4 Add the total number of grades and divide by the number of classes you have.
